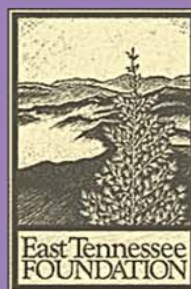
Our Mission

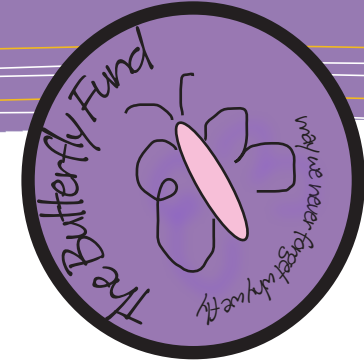

- Each year, cancer kills more children in the United States than any other disease.
- Every day, 43 children are diagnosed with cancer
- 15,700 children will be diagnosed with cancer in the United States this year
- 1 in 330 children will develop cancer by age 20
- 60% of survivors suffer late-effects such as secondary cancers, infertility, and heart failure
- In the last 3 years only 3 cancer treatments specifically for children have been developed
